Brief History of Calvary

Successful mission work in San Lorenzo prompted the purchase of property on Via Magdalena as a church site. The Rev. Waldamar Thiele was called to be the "missionary at large" and by January 1948 the mission outpost claimed 138 adult members and 65 children. The mission achieved congregation status on February 22, 1948 as Calvary Evangelical Lutheran Church.

The congregation immediately undertook to build a church. A combination chapel, parish hall and classroom facility built on the Via Magdalena property was dedicated on December 18, 1949. In December 1975, construction began on a new sanctuary. That building was dedicated on July 25, 1976.

A grade school was established in September 1950. Additional classrooms were added in 1952 and 1974 and more recently in 1993 and 1996. Calvary Lutheran School, pre-school through grade eight, still flourishes staffed by principal Forrest Adams, 10 teachers, school secretary and over 200 students.

Ground was broken for a residence for the elderly in September 1977. Occupancy of that unit -Wittenberg Manor- was accomplished a year later. Plans for additional housing for the elderly began immediately and finally accomplished in 1993 with Wittenberg II.

Calvary provides many opportunities for fellowship, study and worship.
