REVISED ACADEMIC POLICY 8/04

To support the student-athletes at Calvary, we must have clearly set priorities. These priorities are, in order of importance: God and our relationship with Him, our families, school and academic responsibilities, and extra-curricular activities (sports).

In order to encourage and help all student-athletes be successful on the playing field, and in the classroom, the following academic policy has been put in place.

Student-athletes must maintain a grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher, and student-athletes cannot be failing any one class.

Each teacher will communicate to the athletic director every Monday the status of all student-athletes. If a student-athlete is failing a class, or has a GPA lower than 2.0, that person will be ineligible for all games that week – even if the grade comes above failing during the week. They will not be allowed to travel with the team or play in games (this includes the tournament weekends). They will, however, be allowed to practice. All student-athletes must turn in any missing or late work on Friday to be counted in the grades sent out on Monday. Every student-athlete will have a fresh start each new week.

This policy works toward the success of the student-athlete. All teachers, coaches, and administrators have the success of the student-athlete as their top priority.
